Because they live on the land, they must frequently move around in search of food. They have few belongings and little or no clothing. Some tribes of Aborigines, especially those that live in the desert, may move 100 times in a year. They might move more than 1,000 miles on foot during that time. These tribes set up temporary homes, such as tents made of grass. The Aborigines have no written language, but they have developed a system of hand signals. These are used during hunting when silence is necessary and during their religious ceremonies when talking is forbidden.
